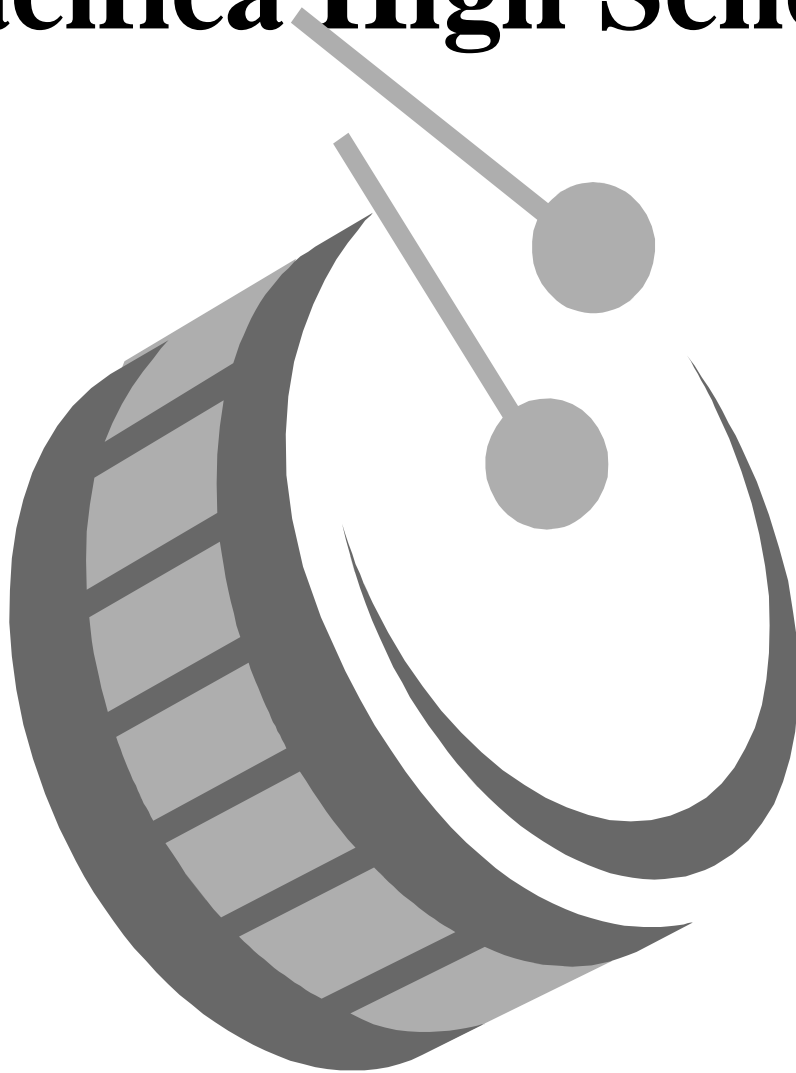

Welcome to the Pacifica High School Boosters programs. We look forward to this being a very positive experience for everyone involved. Research has shown that participation in these types of musically based activities improves not only musical skills, but also academic achievement, memory and attention span, interpersonal relationships and cooperation, self-confidence and stage presence, creativity, expression and personal responsibility.

The Garden Grove Unified School District and Pacifica High School are able to offer basic classroom instruction and regular on-campus and district activities such as school concerts and local music festivals to all interested students. With the assistance of the Parent Volunteers/Booster Club, Pacifica is also able to offer a more comprehensive and exciting co-curricular program to our students. This program includes activities such as participation in off-campus competitions, musical clinics geared towards specific needs, additional instructional staff and musical assistance, and specialized drumline coaching. And this year looks to be an exceptional year with a trip to Dayton Ohio for the WGI World Championships. These additional activities are very fun and definitely worthwhile. But a comprehensive music program like ours incurs many varied expenses.

Program Expenses

The cost per member to field an award winning Instrumental Music program is described below.

Springline	\$425.00, plus Uniforms and shoes
Dayton Trip	\$500.00, plus airfare

Program expenses include, but are not limited to the following: Springline Show design, Drumline competition fees, props and equipment, lighting, sheet music, hourly coaching for sectionals, instrument repairs, trailer registration; truck rental; tax preparation; liability insurance; newsletter; annual expenses (non-profit corporation); special events such as the awards banquet; student awards.

There will be several opportunities throughout the course of the year for everyone to help raise the money needed to cover program expenses. Watch for information on fundraising opportunities such as e-Scrip and Scrip, Sees Candy Sales, Fireworks, Cow Chip Bingo, Restaurant nights, Mail-a-thon, Ralph's, Printer Cartridge Recycling, Quality Firestone Car Repair, etc.

Many families choose to donate rather than participate in fund-raisers. This donation is a 100% tax deductible payment to the Pacifica High School Band and Auxiliary Corps Boosters. This donation is applied to the same activities as our fund-raisers. The "Boosters" is a non-profit corporation under the laws of the State of California whose sole purpose is to help provide funding and support for the Pacifica Instrumental Music Department programs. A receipt will be provided for your tax records following your payment.

2009 DRUMLINE SEASON



REHEARSAL (every week):

Tuesdays - 5:30pm to 9:00pm

Wednesday - 3:00pm to 6:00pm.

Additional rehearsals are added according to the school schedule and as required to finish or refine the show. While our coach, John Mapes, does try to end rehearsals on time, they do often run longer than scheduled due to a variety of factors. Please be patient as it does take time.

COMPETITIONS AND FEES:

The competition schedule may change. However, it is a good idea to plan around this schedule now. The students will not be available for any part of the day on competition days either due to travel time required for the venue or morning rehearsals before the show.

- 3 **TRANSPORTATION:** Students are not transported in buses to competition sites. They are transported by parent volunteers. If you wish to be a driver, please contact Lori Airhart (loriairhart@yahoo.com), our drumline representative, to let her know. You will also need to have on file with Pacifica High School the "Private use of Vehicle" that is found in the back of this packet.
- 3 **MEALS:** Meals are paid for by each student on the day of the competition and generally cost **\$7.00** for each student and parent that will be having a meal at the site. The booster parents do a good job finding a nice meal for this price. Please be sure your student has money for these meals. You may wish to provide them with a little additional money at your discretion as there are t-shirts and other items available for purchase at the shows.
- 3 **SPRINGLINE FEES:** \$425.00 (pays for instructors, instrument maintenance, competition fees, etc.)

3 FINAL COMPETITION IN DAYTON, OHIO:

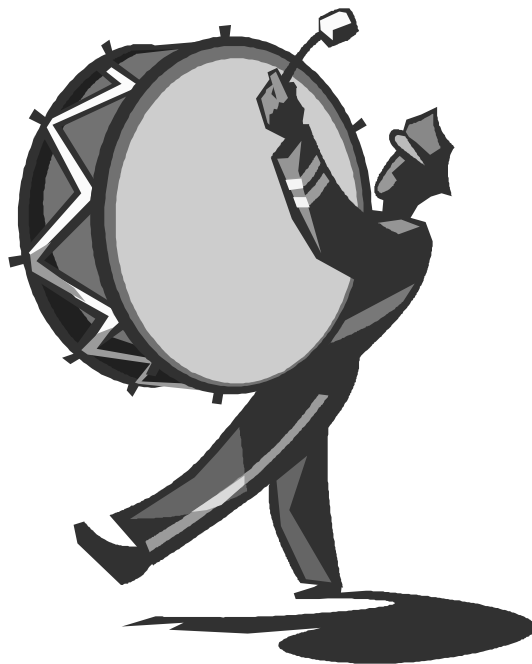
§ **DAYTON FEES:** \$500.00 est. (fee includes hotel, food, transportation, competition fees and rehearsal site fees, etc. *does not include airfare*)

§ **DAYTON AIRFARE:** Approximately \$492.00 (amount subject to change, includes luggage fee, tax and other airline fees)

*The group must have approval from the school district before final travel arrangements can be made. Once approval is granted, final bookings with airlines and hotels will occur. **We are expecting to receive the airfare fee to book the flights by December 22.** These are the estimated travel costs. You will be informed of any changes once everything has been finalized. Please budget accordingly as late payments will likely increase the airfare price further due to airline restrictions or could mean your student will not be able to travel to Dayton.*

3 UNIFORMS:

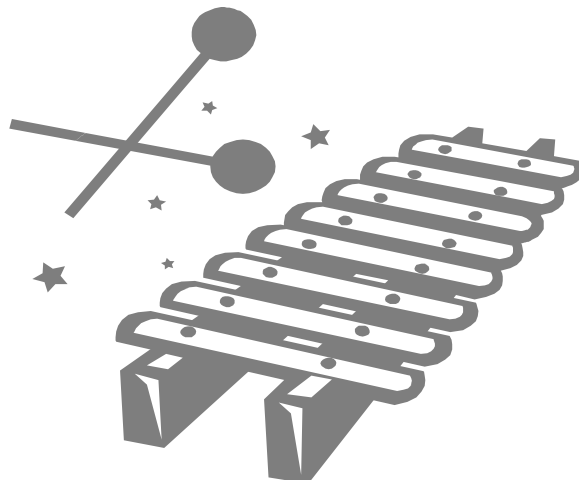
§ Uniforms are custom made each season and run on average of 100.00 plus shoes. The first deposit for uniforms is generally \$50.00 and due in December but could change depending on the total cost of the uniform. The balance will be due sometime in January. Please budget accordingly. Students get to keep this uniform when the season is over.

We will also be purchasing shoes and athletic shirt, price will depend on the type of shoe that is needed. This will be done in January prior to our first competition in February.

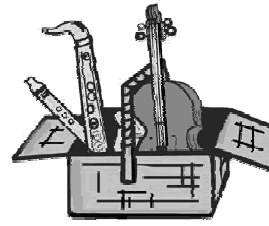

USE OF PRIVATE VEHICLE

Private vehicles being operated for District purposes must meet the following guidelines.

1. Driver must possess:
 - a. Valid California driver's license.
 - b. Minimum Liability Insurance of \$100,000.
2. Number of passengers shall not exceed ten (10), including the driver. **In no case shall the number of passengers, including driver, exceed the number of available seatbelts in the Vehicle.**
3. Trips must be approved, in advance, by the appropriate school or program administrator.
4. All drivers, (whether employees or volunteers), must be approved by the District prior to Departure.
5. Vehicle form "Use of Private Vehicle" must be completed, approved and on file in the approved office prior to departure.
6. Use of vehicles where knowledge of hazardous road conditions exist is prohibited. This Includes hazardous conditions declared by California Highway Patrol (CHP), or other city, County, state or federal agencies authorized to monitor road conditions.
7. Prior to departure, the driver shall be instructed by the appropriate school or program administrator as follows:
 - a. Follow the most direct route.
 - b. Avoid unnecessary, unscheduled stops.
 - c. Do not carry non-District personnel, non-students or other "guests" as Passengers unless prior authorization has been issued by the District.
 - d. Do not carry more than ten (10) passengers, including the driver, regardless of the size of the vehicle; otherwise the vehicle used must be a school bus or student pupil Activity bus as defined in the California Vehicle Code and operated by a driver licensed for that type of vehicle.
